Ryan Kules, Combat Stress Recovery National Director

As Combat Stress Recovery Program (CSRP) National Director, Ryan Kules oversees the operations of the CSRP team. The CSRP provides interactive programs, outdoor rehabilitative retreats, peer support, and professional services to post-9/11 veterans. These programs and services improve resiliency and psychological well-being of warriors and enable them to maintain healthy, meaningful relationships, while pursuing life goals without the barriers or stigmas associated with mental health issues.

Ryan was born in Phoenix, Arizona and attended Arizona State University. There, he completed the Army ROTC program and was commissioned as an Armor Officer. After graduating from Armor Officer Basic and Airbourne schools, Ryan’s first duty station was Fort Riley, KS where he was assigned to 1st Battalion, 13th Armor Regiment. He deployed to Iraq in February 2005 and led patrols, raids, and cordon and searches in the area surrounding the base.

On November 29, 2005, while returning from an early morning cordon and search, Ryan’s vehicle was hit with an improvised explosive device buried in the road. He was evacuated to Walter Reed Army Medical Center and remained in a coma for two weeks before beginning the process of rehabilitation.

Ryan retired from the Army as a Captain in May 2007, and he and his wife decided to relocate to the D.C. area. Ryan resides in Severna Park, Maryland, and enjoys spending time with his wife, Nancy, and their three children: Jillian, Liv, and Evan.

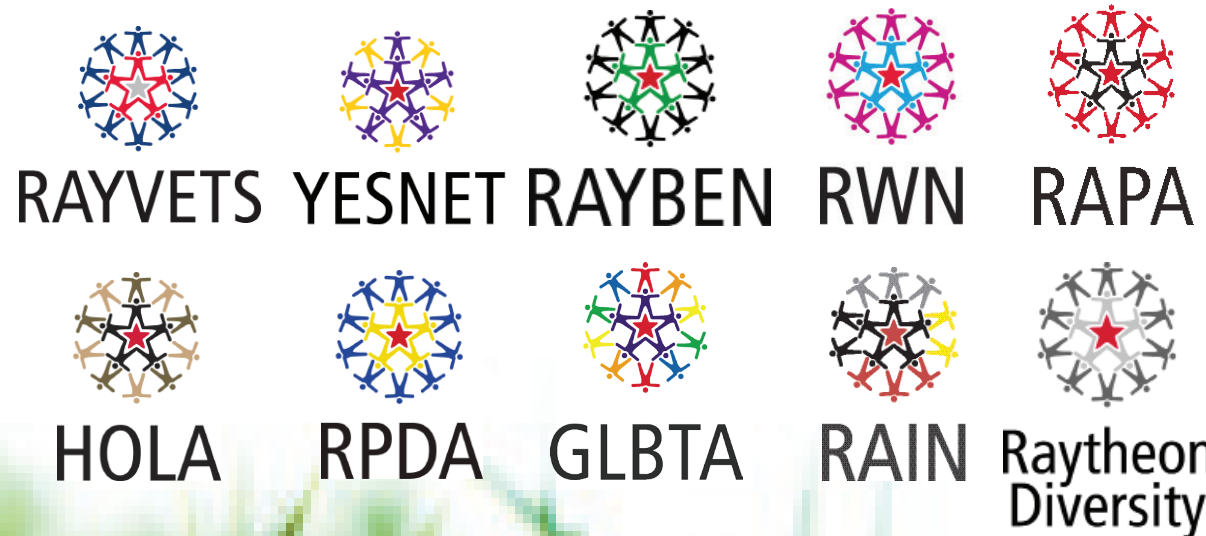
